## AWARD CATEGORIES

**Energy Company of the Year** for the most successful company of 2005, not only in terms of financial results, but also based on the goals set and the achievement of targets. These may include exploration and production activity, joint venture partnerships, acquisitions strategies and corporate development.

**Most Enterprising Exploration Company of the Year** for a company, large or small, that is perceived to have shown innovation in managing complex operations overseas, for example, using local fabrication and labour content, or overcoming environmental challenges to become a role model in exploration and production. Special recognition will go to companies who have overcome significant difficulties in 2005.

**Energy Executive of the Year** recognises the exceptional contribution of one key individual who has made a significant improvement in the management of operations of their company in 2005. Nominations can include individuals who have made considerable differences within one area of the business, as well as those who have succeeded in company-wide challenges.

**Corporate Communications Team of the Year** acknowledges the team whose communications strategy has increased the value of their brand in the industry in 2005, through communication with customers, employees and other stakeholders.

**Best Project Finance Deal of the Year** recognises the most innovative and financially sound structure for an energy project, which closed according to schedule in 2005.

**Best Youth Educational Programme** for an organisation that has contributed most to developing and implementing an educational programme introducing young people to the energy industry as a potential future career path.

**Cleaner Energy Initiative Award** for an organisation making concerted efforts to improve operations and promote technologies for reducing emissions. This award will look particularly at those companies who have taken positive action to reduce carbon and other emissions, flaring or are seeking to produce 'cleaner' alternative energy.

**Investor Relations Team of the Year** that has most developed their company image through improved relations with investors. Success will have been reflected in the company share price in 2005.

**In-House Legal Team of the Year** recognises the most successful in-house legal team in the execution of external energy contracts.

**Accounting Transparency Award** for the company that has made significant efforts over the previous accounting year in accounting disclosure.
